- 1) Call to Order / Roll Call Emily Messa, CASP
- 2) Approval of the October 26, 2024 Meeting Minutes *Emily Messa, CASP M/S/P Ron Portwine / Angela Peterson to approve the October 26, 2024 minutes.*

Strategic Issues

- 3) 2024 Review and Accomplishments Emily Messa, CASP
 - a. C3X 2024 Flip-A-Coin
 - i. Through both the CX events and C3X, the NACAS Foundation raised over a record breaking \$16,000.
 - b. Cornerstones
 - i. Many Cornerstones indicated that they were not interested in fundraising.
 - ii. Social media posts proved to be successful in raising awareness but generated very few donations.
 - iii. Suggestion was made to incorporate fundraising into the CX events and launch the announcements far earlier in the year.
 - c. Regional contributions
 - i. Regional support was a major part of the Foundation's ability to support the DIAL program. In 2025, asks of the region will include a specific program that their donation will be supporting.
 - d. DIAL support
 - i. Suggestion was made to phrase support of the DIAL program as supporting the region's future leadership pipeline.
 - e. Leadership contributions
 - 65% of the NACAS Board of Directors and NACAS Foundation Board of Directors met the 'soft launch' of the donation expectations. More will be mentioned around 2025 donation goals at LTM.

- f. Club Colors
 - The preliminary site has been built to sell NACAS Foundation related items. The NACAS Regions will also be using this platform to procure / sell their regional gear.
 - ii. Need to earn \$4,000 in royalties to break even due to set-up fees.
- 4) LTM Topics of Interest Emily Messa, CASP
 - a. Timeline development
 - Emily and William are working on an annual timeline for broader Foundation review. This will include milestones like securing sponsorships, launching marketing campaigns, and communicating awards.
 - b. Integrating students into NACAS
 - i. Re-development of Student Author Contest
 - 1. There is a possibility that the NACAS Foundation may re-start and re-envision the Student Author Contest, allowing broader participation of undergraduate and/or graduate students. This could lead to participation at C3X in a student panel or provide research data around the impact auxiliaries have on students.

Review & Adjustment of Strategy

- 5) Treasurer Report Jim Dwyer, CASP
 - a. A more formal presentation will be given at LTM.
 - b. The Foundation fidelity investment has a positive change of \$88,910 for 2025.
 - c. Overall, our 2024 operating expenses did exceed operating revenue (which was offset by investment gain) and we are looking to correct that for our current year budget.
 - d. Shoring up regional contributions, Cornerstone donations, and leadership donations will support our revised budget to ensure our positive financial health.
- 6) NACAS/ Foundation MOU Jim Dwyer, CASP
 - a. The MOU was approved by the NACAS Foundation at C3X 2024 and is currently on the docket for the NACAS Board of Directors to approve.
- 7) KASA disbursements Jim Dwyer, CASP
 - a. NACAS is working on adjusting language to make the KASA agreement more generalized. This will allow us to best use the funds to support Kentucky based institutions.
- 8) Central Past Presidents' Scholarship Jim Dwyer, CASP
 - a. Recommendation was made to shift the temporary restricted fund be made a permanent restricted fund, effective 1/1/2025
 - b. Will be voted upon at LTM due to lack of quorum.
