#### **Strategic Issues**

#### Flip A Coin Update:

Dr. Emily Messa provided an update on the Flip A Coin fundraising initiative, including:

- Raising just under \$7,000 from regional CX events
- Proposal to sell unlimited beads at \$20 each and allow donations during Flip a Coin
- Presenting the idea to have a commemorative foundation board t-shirt available for those who sign up for recurring gifts

Mr. Ron Portwine shared updates on the work being done to update the foundation's bylaws and policies:

- Align board member service terms with the NACAS national board
- Adding a past president role for continuity
- Discussing the expected annual contribution amounts for business partner vs. institutional board members
- · Considering travel reimbursement policies to support inclusivity

#### **Review & Adjustment of Strategy**

Mr. Matt Portner provided an update on the MOU between the foundation and NACAS, noting that it is ready for review by the foundation's executive committee. - Work on the 2024 budget and exploring e-commerce opportunities
